P132-M budgeted for Cavite historical sites

CITY OF IMUL
Cavite – The national government allocated this year P132 million for improving or reconstructing Cavite's historical sites.

The budget was contained in the 2019 General Appropriations Act (GAA) that Malacañang's Official Gazette published last April 26.

Here is how the budget is broken down:

• P82 million for the construction of the "Shang Laya" or Mother's Freedom Monument and installation of LED streetlights at the Heritage Park in Barangay Alayon II

• P40 million for renovating the Iloilo Ancestral Museum and lights and sounds for

Blood pressure in our 30s and 40s has lasting impact on brain health

A new study followed adults from their mid-30s into their early 70s. It shows an association between blood pressure changes in early adulthood and midlife and brain changes at the endpoint of the study.

At what age should we start monitoring people's blood pressure?

High blood pressure, or hypertension, is a risk factor for cardiovascular disease, stroke, and kidney disease.

With around 15-20% of our blood going to the brain, the National Institute of Ag-

ing (NIA), part of the National Institutes of Health (NIH), explain that 'the blood flow that keeps the brain healthy can, if reduced or blocked, harm this essential organ.'

A recent study, which Medical News Today featured earlier this month, indicates that intensive blood pressure treatment in mid-life -- or lowering of systolic blood pressure to below 120 millimeters of mercury (mm Hg) -- is linked to fewer white matter lesions in the brain in later life.

Scratching the surface of how your brain senses an itch

Light touch plays a

critical role in everyday tasks, such as picking up a glass or playing a musical instrument. The sensation is also an essential part of the body's protective defense system, alerting us to objects in our environment that could cause us to fall or injure ourselves. In addition, it is part of the detection system that has evolved to protect us from biting insects, such as those that cause malaria and Lyme disease, by eliciting a feeling of an itch when an insect lands on your skin.

Salk researchers have discovered how neurons in the spinal cord help transmit such itch signals to the brain. Published in the journal *Cell Reports* on July 16, 2018, their findings help contribute to a better understanding of itch and could lead to new drugs to treat chronic itch, which occurs in some conditions as ex-

cessive eczema, diabetes and even some cancers. "The sensation of this mechanical itch is distinct from other forms of touch and it has this specialized pathway within the spinal cord," says Salk Professor Martyn Goulding. He and Jennifer J. Mitchell-Chang and a senior author of the new work, Goulding and his colleagues had previously discovered a set of inhibitory neurons in the spinal cord that act like cellular brakes, keeping the mechanical itch pathway in the spinal cord turned off most of the time. Without these neurons, which produce the neurotransmitter neuropeptide Y (NPY), the mechanical itch pathway is constantly on, causing chronic itch. What the researchers didn't know was how the itch signal, which under normal circumstances is suppressed by the NPY neurons, is transmitted to the brain to register the itch sensation.

Inflammation in type 2 diabetes: Study overturns previous notions

New research dispels the prevalent notion that glucose drives inflammation in obesity-related type 2 diabetes. The findings may explain why so many treatments to prevent complications in type 2 diabetes have failed.

Researchers used cell culture experiments to reveal that defects in the cells' mitochondria, along with exposure to certain types of fats,

drive inflammation in type 2 diabetes. Chronic inflammation is the root cause of many of diabetes complications, including cardiovascular and kidney disease.

Until now, the scientific consensus has been that glucose drives inflammation in type 2 diabetes.

But new research counters this popular notion and points in-

stead to high levels of lipids and defects in mitochondria — the tiny energy-producing organelles inside cells.

Barbara Mikolajczyk from the Department of Pharmacology and Nutritional Sciences at the University of Kentucky, Bernadette Brown Diabetes Center in Lexington is the lead author of the new study.

"We've found common ways human and plant cells bring about cell suicide."

The team used a combination of structural biology, biochemistry, neurobiology and plant science to analyze cells and proteins, laying the foundation for some potentially ground-breaking innovations.

"Neurodegenerative diseases affect millions of people worldwide, and come about for different reasons, but what connects them is the breakdown of brain cells," Professor **Kobe** said.

"A particular protein - **SARM1** - is essential for this brain cell breakdown across different neurodegenerative diseases.

"We've provided crucial information about this protein - revealing its three-dimensional structure - but what connects them, that will accelerate the development of drugs that could delay or stop this breakdown."

Optic nerve stimulation to aid the blind

Scientists from EPFL in Switzerland and Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna in Italy are developing technology for the blind that bypasses the eye itself entirely and sends messages to the brain. They do this by stimulating the optic nerve with a new type of intraneural electrode called OptoSELDNE. Successfully tested in rabbits, they report their results in *Nature Biomedical Engineering*.

"We believe that intraneural stimulation can be a valuable solution for several neuroprosthetic devices for sensory and motor function restoration. The translational potentials of this approach are indeed extremely promising," explains Silvestro Micera, EPFL's Bernardi Foundation Chair in Translational Neuroengineering, and Professor of Bioelectronics at Scuola

Superiore Sant'Anna, who continues to innovate in hand prosthetics for amputees using intraneural electrodes.

Blindness affects an estimated 39 million people in the world. Many factors can induce blindness, like genetics, retinal detachment, trauma, stroke in the visual cortex, glaucoma, cataract, inflammation or infection. Some blindness is temporary and can be treated medically.

How do you help someone who is permanently blind?

The idea is to produce phosphors, the sensation of seeing light in the form of white patterns, without seeing light directly. Retinal implants, a prosthetic device for helping the blind, suffer from exclusion criteria. For example, 3 million people worldwide are blind due to Retinitis pigmentosa,

a genetic disorder, but only a few hundred patients qualify for retinal implants for clinical reasons.

A brain implant that stimulates the visual cortex directly is another strategy albeit risky. A priori, the new intraneural solution minimizes exclusion criteria since the optic nerve and the pathway to the brain are often intact.

Previous attempts to stimulate the optic nerve in the 1990s provided inconclusive results. EPFL's Massimo Chini, Chair in Neuroengineering Design, explains: "Back then, they used cuff nerve electrodes. The problem is that these electrodes are rigid and they move around, so the electrical stimulation of the nerve fibers becomes unstable.

Researchers find a way to stop lung damage due to the body's immune response

University of Calgary researchers at the Cumming School of Medicine (CSM) led by Drs. Donna Senger, PhD, Paul Kubin, PhD, and Stephen Robbins, PhD have discovered a new way to stop harmful inflammation in the lungs due to sepsis and injury.

"This work demonstrates the power of collaboration in solving complex health issues to benefit patients," says Robbins,

a professor in the departments of Oncology and Biochemistry & Molecular Biology and Scientific Director of the CCRB Institute of Cancer Research. "The research involved teams from 10 laboratories, nine at UCalgary with investigators from the Azria Cancer Centre, Cancer Institute and the Snyder Institute for Chronic Diseases."

sepsis. It occurs when the body is fighting off severe infection. The immune system goes into overdrive sending white blood cells to clear up the infection. The battle between your immune system and the infection leads to inflammation.
