## Cavite to soon open 'biggest COVID-19 testing lab in the country'

Cavite may soon be able to conduct around 10,000 COVID-19 tests a day with the upcoming opening of a testing laboratory that can facilitate 1,000 tests daily, Gov. Janvic Batallas said last July 30.

"In Cavite, we are doing our best. The biggest testing laboratory in the country is about to open at DLSU (De La Salle University) Dasmariñas. 1,000 tests a day, 7 days a week," he said in a Facebook post.

Once the laboratory at the university opens to the public, this will bring Cavite's testing capacity to 10,000 tests per day, Batallas said.

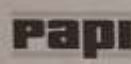

## New blood test shows great promise in the diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease

A new blood test demonstrated remarkable promise in discriminating between persons with and without Alzheimer's disease and in persons at known genetic risk may be able to detect the disease as early as 20 years before the onset of cognitive impairment, according to a large international study published July 29, 2020 in the Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA) and simultaneously presented at the Alzheimer's Association International Conference.

For many years, the diagnosis of Alzheimer's has been based on the characterization of amyloid plaques and tau tangles in the brain, typically after a person dies. An inexpensive and widely available blood test for the

presence of plaques and tangles would have a profound impact on Alzheimer's research and care. According to the study, measurements of phospho-tau217 (p-tau217), one of the tau proteins found in tangles, could provide a relatively sensitive and accurate indicator of both plaques and tangles — corresponding in the diagnosis of Alzheimer's — in living people.

The p-tau217 blood test has great promise in the diagnosis, early detection, and study of Alzheimer's," said Oskar Hansson, MD, PhD, Professor of Clinical Memory Research at Lund University, Sweden, who leads the Swedish BioFINDER Study and senior author on the study who spearheaded the international collaborative effort.

# Alzheimer's risk factors may be measurable in adolescents and young adults

Risk factors for Alzheimer's dementia may be apparent as early as our teens and 20s, according to new research reported at the Alzheimer's Association International Conference (AAIC) 2020.

These risk factors, many of which are disproportionately apparent in African Americans, include heart health factors — such as high blood pressure, high cholesterol and diabetes — and social factors like education quality. According to the Alzheimer's Association Alzheimer's Disease Facts and Figures report, older African Americans are about twice as likely to have Alzheimer's as whites.

"By identifying, measuring, and acting to counter these Alzheimer's

risk factors that we can change, we may reduce new cases and eventually the total number of people with Alzheimer's and other dementias," said Maria C. Carrillo, Ph.D., Alzheimer's Association chief science officer. "Research like this is important in addressing health inequities and providing resources that could make a positive impact on a person's life."

"These new reports from AAIC 2020 show that it's never too early, or too late, to take action to protect your memory and thinking abilities," Carrillo said.

The Alzheimer's Association is leading the U.S. Study to Protect Brain Health Through Lifestyle Intervention to Reduce Risk (U.S. POINTER), a two-year clinical trial to evaluate

whether lifestyle interventions that simultaneously target many risk factors protect cognitive function in older adults who are at increased risk for cognitive decline. U.S. POINTER is the first such study to be conducted in a large, diverse group of Americans across the United States.

In a population of more than 714 African Americans in the Study of Healthy Aging in African Americans (STAR), Kristen George, Ph.D., MPH, of the University of California, Davis, and colleagues found that high blood pressure and diabetes, or a combination of multiple heart health-related factors, are common in adolescence and are associated with worse late-life cognition. Study participants were adolescents (16-19, ages 13-20),

young adults (20-49), ages 51-64) and adults (65-100), ages 39-90). Mean age at cognitive assessment was 68.

Cognition was measured using in-person tests of memory and executive function. The researchers found that, in this study population, having diabetes, high blood pressure, or two or more heart health risk factors in adolescence, young adulthood, or mid-life was associated with statistically significantly worse late-life cognition. These differences persisted after accounting for age, gender, years since risk factors were measured, and education.

Before this report, little was known about whether cardiovascular disease (CVD) risk factors developed prior to mid-life were associated with late-life cognition.

# Higher BPA levels linked to more asthma symptoms in children

Children in low-income neighborhoods in Baltimore tended to have more asthma symptoms when levels of the synthetic chemical BPA (Bisphenol A) in their urine were elevated, according to a study from researchers at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health and School of Medicine.

While some products, including baby bottles, no longer contain BPA, exposures to BPA remain almost universal, and there are still concerns that, especially in childhood, these exposures might have a health impact.

Boys with elevated BPA were found to be at higher risk for having more asthma symptoms, the study found. The researchers found no statistically significant link between BPA levels and asthma symptoms among the

girls in the study. The researchers also found that higher levels of two common chemicals closely related to BPA — BPS and BPF — were not consistently associated with more asthma symptoms. Like BPA, BPS and BPF are found in many consumer products, including food cans and beverage bottles.

For their analysis, the researchers examined clinical data and urine samples, taken at three-month intervals over a year, from 148 predominantly Black children in Baltimore. They found consistent links between higher BPA levels in urine and measures of recent asthma severity.

The study, published July 28 in the *Journal of Allergy and Clinical Immunology*, is thought to be the first to examine children's environmental exposures to BPA, BPS, and BPF and their associations with asthma severity.

"Our findings suggest that additional studies are needed to examine this BPA-asthma link, given the high burden of pediatric asthma and widespread exposure to BPA in the United States," says lead author Lezliam Quiros-Alcala, PhD, assistant professor in the Department of Environmental Health and Engineering at the Bloomberg School.

"This is especially important given that Black Americans have higher asthma rates than whites and also, according to CDC data, have higher exposures to these chemicals than whites." BPA is a chemical building block used to make polycarbonate plastic, as well as some epoxies. Produced at the rate of about 7 million tons per year worldwide, it can leach from polycarbonate bottles into the liquids they contain, and from epoxies that line cans of soup and other food items. A 2011 study published found that eating soup from cans lined with BPA-containing epoxy caused study participants' BPA levels to rise by a factor of almost 20.

BPA can activate estrogen receptors in cells, which suggests that it may have hormone-like effects — disrupting human biology even at very small exposure levels. Animal studies have found evidence that the chemical can have pro-inflammatory effects. Epidemiological studies have found that people with higher BPA levels in their urine are more likely to have cardiovascular disease, diabetes, asthma, and some other conditions.

Children are in particular more vulnerable, to the extent that they use BPA-containing products more often than adults do. Due to consumer concerns, companies stopped making BPA-containing baby bottles and sippy cups more than a decade ago, and have largely switched to non-BPA can epoxies.

## Rapid test for the determination of antibodies against Sars-Cov-2

To determine im- munity in Sars-Cov-2 and the effectiveness of potential vaccines, the amount of neu- tralizing antibodies in the blood of recoverd or vaccinated individ- uals must be deter- mined. A tradition- al neutralization test usually takes two to three days and must be carried out with in- fectious coronavirus in a laboratory com- plying to biosafety level 3. A Swiss-Ger- man research team from Bern and Bo- chum has launched a test that takes only 18 hours and doesn't have high biosafety requirements. The re- searchers have pub- lished their report in the journal *Vaccines* on 13 July 2020.

The test was de- veloped at the Insti- tute of Virology and Immunology (IVI) of the University of Bern and the Swiss Federal Office for Food-Saf- ety and Animal Health, and evaluated in coop- eration with colleagues from the Ruhr-Univer- sität Bochum (RUB) using serum samples from Covid-19 pa- tients.

In order to detect antibodies against Sars-Cov-2, the re- searchers used smoth- er virus that doesn't propagate. They ex- changed the envelope protein of this virus for the spike protein of the novel coronavirus, which mediates virus entry and infection. "As a result, the virus- es can be identified

by antibodies against Sars-Cov-2," explains lead author Toni-Lu- ise Meisler from the Department of Mo- lecular and Medical Virology at Ruhr-Uni- versität Bochum. "The antibodies bind to the viruses that have been altered in this way and neutralise them so that no longer can pene- trate the host cells."

Since the virus pseudotyped in this way can't propagate in host cells, no elaborate bio- safety precautions are necessary for the test. In order to determine the amount of antibodies, the researchers gene- rally modified the virus so that green fluorescent protein and a luciferase, an enzyme from fire- flies, will be produced in infected cells.

## 'Drawn-on-skin' electronics offer breakthrough in wearable monitors

A team of research- ers led by Jianfang Yu, Bill D. Cook As- sociate Professor of Mechanical Engineer- ing at the University of Houston, has de- veloped a new form of electronics known as "drawn-on-skin electronics," allowing multifunctional sen- sors and circuits to be drawn on the skin with an ink pen.

The advance, the re- searchers report in *Nature Communications*, allows for the collec- tion of more precise, motion artifact-free health data, solving the long-standing problem of collecting precise bi- ological data through a wearable device when the subject is in mo- tion.

The imprecise may not be import-

ant when your Fitbit registers 4,200 steps instead of 4,205, but sensors designed to check heart function, temperature and other physical signals must be accurate if they are to be used for diagnos- tics and treatment.

The drawn-on-skin electronics are able to seamlessly collect data, regardless of the wear- er's movements.
