## Cavite among 17 provinces to face drought

The Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical, and Astronomical Services Administration (Pagasa) said 17 provinces in Luzon and Visayas or 20 percent of the country may experience drought, while three provinces in Visayas or 4 percent of the country may have dry spell by the end of May.

Provinces that may experience drought are Batan, Metro Manila, Cavite, Marinduque, Bataan, Albay, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, Cebu, Iloilo, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, Zamboanga, and Zamboanga City.

These comprise 20 percent of the country.

Drought, which

is a severe dry condition, is defined as three

consecutive months

of way below normal (60 percent reduction

from average) or five

consecutive months of below normal (21 to 60

percent reduction from

average) rainfall condition.

Bohol, Cebu, and Southern Leyte may experience dry spell by end of May.

Dry spell is described by Pagasa as three consecutive months of below normal (21 to 50 percent reduction from average) rainfall conditions or two consecutive months of way below normal (more than 60 percent reduction from average) rainfall conditions.

Pagasa said 41 provinces are currently experiencing drought, while 23 provinces are confronting dry spell.

Most of the country will have generally near normal rainfall in

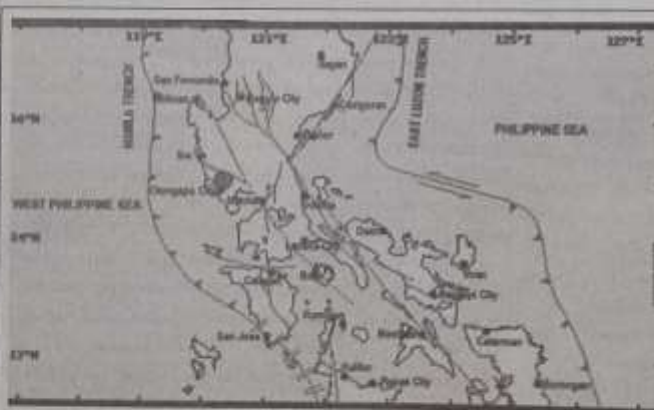

### Quake also rocks Cavite

IMUS CITY, Cavite - The powerful earthquake that shook a wide area of Luzon at 5:11 p.m. last April 22 was felt as a magnitude IV in Tagaytay City, while only as a magnitude III in the

cities of Dasmariñas, General Trias, Cavite and the town of Indang, the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (Phivolcs) reported.

Phivolcs' earth-

quake information no. 2, issued at 6:03 p.m. last April 22 traced the magnitude 6.1 earthquake's epicenter around 18 km north 67° E of Castillejos (Zambales), with a depth of focus measured

at 12 km.

The agency said the quake was tectonic in origin.

# Engineers make injectable tissues a reality

A simple injection that can help regrow damaged tissue has long been the dream of physicians and patients alike. A new study from researchers at UBC Okanagan moves that dream closer to reality with a device that makes encapsulating cells much faster, cheaper and more effective.

"The idea of injecting different kinds of tissue cells is not a new one," says Keekyoung Kim, assistant professor of engineering at UBC Okanagan and study co-author. "It's an enticing concept because by introducing cells into damaged tissue, we can super-

charge the body's own processes to regrow and repair an injury."

Kim says everything from broken bones to torn ligaments could benefit from this kind of approach and suggests even whole organs could be repaired as the technology improves.

The problem, he says, is that cells on their own are delicate and tend not to survive when injected directly into the body.

"It turns out that to ensure cell survival, they need to be encased in a coating that protects them from physical damage and from the body's own immune system," says

Mohamed Gamal, doctoral student in biomedical engineering and study lead author.

"But it has been extremely difficult to do that kind of cell encapsulation, which has until now been done in a very costly, time-consuming and wasteful process."

Kim and Gamal have solved that problem by developing an automated encapsulation device that encases many cells in a microgel using a specialized blue laser and purifies them to produce a clean, usable sample in just a few minutes. The advantage of their system is that over 85 per cent

of the cells survive and the process can be easily scaled up.

"Research in this area has been hampered by the cost and lack of availability of mass-produced cell encapsulated microgels," says Kim. "We've solved that problem and our system could provide thousands or even tens of thousands of cell-encapsulated microgels rapidly, so percharging this field of bioengineering."

In addition to developing a system that's quick and efficient, Gamal says the equipment is made up of readily available and inexpensive components.

Pagnas said the weak El Niño still persists and may continue until August.

# An army of micro-robots can wipe out dental plaque

A visit to the dentist typically involves time-consuming and sometimes unpleasant scraping with mechanical tools to remove plaque from teeth. What if, instead, a dentist could deploy a small army of tiny robots to precisely and non-invasively remove that buildup?

A team of engineers, dentists, and biologists from the University of Pennsylvania developed a micro-robotic cleaning crew. With two types of robotic systems — one designed to work on surfaces and the other to operate inside confined spaces — the scientists showed that robots with catalytic activity could ably destroy biofilms of bacteria enmeshed in a protective scaffolding. Such robotic film-removal systems could be valuable in a wide range of potential applications from keeping water pipes and catheters clean to reducing the risk of tooth decay, endodontic infections, and implant

contamination. The work, published in *Science Robotics*, was led by Hyun (Michel) Koo of the School of Dental Medicine and Edward Steger of the School of Engineering and Applied Science.

"This was a truly synergistic and multidisciplinary intersection," says Koo. "We're leveraging the expertise of microbiologists and clinician-scientists as well as engineers to design the best microbial eradication system possible. This is important to other biomedical fields facing drug-resistant biofilms as we approach a post-antibiotic era."

"Treating biofilms that occur in teeth requires a great deal of manual labor, both on the part of the consumer and the professional," adds Steger. "We hope to improve treatment options as well as reduce the difficulty of care." Biofilms can arise on biological surfaces, such as on a tooth or in a joint or on objects, like water pipes, implants, or catheters.

**Synthetic speech generated from brain recordings**

A state-of-the-art real-sounding synthetic brain-machine interface speech by using brain activity to control a virtual vocal tract -- an anatomically detailed

computer simulation including the lips, jaw, tongue, and larynx. The study was conducted in research participants with intact speech, but the technology could one day restore the voices of people who have lost the ability to speak due to paralysis and other forms of neurological damage.

Stroke, traumatic brain injury, and neurodegenerative diseases such as Parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis, and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS, or Lou Gehrig's disease) often result in an irreversible loss of the ability to speak.

Some people with severe speech disabilities learn to spell out their thoughts letter-by-letter using assistive devices that track very small eye or facial muscle movements. However, producing text or synthesized speech with such devices is laborious, error-prone, and painfully slow, typically permitting a maximum of 10 words per minute, compared to the 100-150 words per minute of natural speech.

An international group of researchers shows the long-term effects has taken one of the first major steps in finding the biological changes in the brain that drive fetal alcohol spectrum disorder (FASD).

New work using chaos theory to analyze brain signals discussed this month in the journal *Chaos*.

Researchers found that teenagers who were exposed to alcohol while in the womb showed altered brain connections that were consistent with impaired cognitive performance. Their findings were reached by measuring the responses

from a brain imaging technique called magnetoencephalography (MEG) and then analyzing them with tools developed using chaos theory.

## Significant delays in West Nile virus reporting

Mouat Sinai researchers found significant delays in reporting human cases of West Nile virus, hampering real-time forecasting of the potentially deadly mosquito-borne disease, according to a study in the JAMA Network Open in April.

Researchers discovered that reports of human cases of West Nile virus in the United States were delayed by two to 14 weeks between illness onset and confirmation of West Nile. The lags were due to the length of time it took health departments to confirm a West Nile case or reporting delays between health care professionals and the health department.

They also found

that reporting of mosquitoes testing positive for the virus were also delayed, but by a much less significant amount of time.

The study showed that accurate and reliable forecasts of West Nile outbreaks are possible using a mathematical model and real-time reports of human and mosquitoes testing positive of the disease, but it is impossible with the lags in reporting that exist. Better and more reliable forecasts would improve mosquito abatement which to tamp down the spread of the virus as well as allow public officials to issue more accurate health information to the community in real time, preventing possible

illness and deaths.

“Current reporting delays impact our understanding of how an outbreak is progressing, and our research highlights areas in which disease surveillance can improve,” said lead author Nicholas DeFolice, Assistant Professor of Environmental Medicine & Public Health at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai. “With improved surveillance, there is greater potential for objective infectious disease forecasts that will allow public health officials to address infectious disease threats in a proactive fashion.”

West Nile virus is the most common domestically acquired mosquito-borne virus in the United States.

## Association between high blood PCB levels and premature death

High levels of polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) in the blood are associated with premature death. This is shown by a cross-disciplinary study based on 1,000 randomly selected 70-year-olds in Uppsala, that is published in the JAMA Network Open journal April 26, 2019.

The study is one in a series of studies from a cross-disciplinary collaboration, which has now lasted more than ten years, between Pro-

fessors Lars Lind and Monica Lind at Uppsala University and environmental chemists at Chalmers University. It shows health risks associated with PCBs, although these substances have long been banned.

Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs) are a group of environmental pollutants that are subject to restrictions in many countries, and many have reduced their concentrations in the environment. But since

these substances do not pose very slowly and are stored in fatty tissues, they remain present in animals and humans. In particular, PCBs with many chlorine atoms in the molecule persist in most Swedes' blood.

In the study known as FIVUS (Prospective Investigation of the Vasculature in Uppsala Seniors), more than 1,000 randomly selected 70-year-olds in Uppsala were monitored over a long period.
